

Orange Shirts 2023-2024

Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission (SJM) residential school commemoration event held in Williams Lake, BC Canada in 2013. It grew out of Physillis' story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the Mission. It has become an opportunity to keep the discussion on all aspects of residential school happening annually.

Our school division will recognize Orange Shirt Day on Friday, September 29th, 2023.

Each shirt is \$14.00 for youth or adults. \$1.00 from every shirt purchased will go towards an Indigenous Education Services Student Scholarship.


